Delta Phi Epsilon Educational Foundation Scholarship Readers Needed for 2018-2019!

The Delta Phi Epsilon Educational Foundation is seeking alumnae who are committed to providing scholarships and funding for educational opportunities to serve on the Reading Team for the Foundation Scholarship Program. Scholarship Readers read, evaluate, and score the essay portion of undergraduate and graduate or professional school scholarship applications.

We are seeking 20 new volunteers to begin **January 15**, who will read an average of 5 applications per week, until February 15. We will also need a second tier reading team to holistically review the top 50-60 applications for final determination. The second tier team will have 2 weeks to read with a deadline of **March 1**.

The priority deadline to apply to read is SEPTEMBER 5, 2018.

Qualifications:

- Undergraduate degree attained at least 5 years ago.
- Desire to serve the sorority in the capacity of reading and evaluating scholarship applications.
- Resumé, CV, or description of related life experiences required with application.

Expectations:

- Participate in Reading Team training via conference call or completing recorded training. Time commitment: 2 hours.
 - 1 hour preparation from mailed training materials
 - 1 hour live online or recorded training
- Available for the reading cycle January 15-February 15.
- Read and score approximately 20 scholarship applicant essays (1-2 500-word essays per applicant). Time commitment: approximately 5-10 hours over the course of the month at your convenience.

The 2017-2018 scholarship cycle was our largest to date with 46 volunteers reviewing close to 300 applications. The Foundation was able to award \$100,000 to 37 deserving recipients. We are hoping to increase our capacity across the board this year in volunteers, applications, and recipients.
